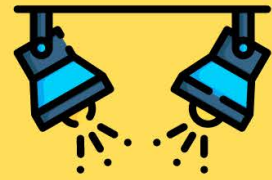




Board Member Spotlight



JEFF LECOCQ



Captain Jeff LeCocq is a life long resident of Muskingum County, graduating from Zanesville High School in 1982. Capt. LeCocq is a 1985 graduate of Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy, completing training at the then Muskingum Area Technical College on Newark Rd. He started his career at Muskingum County Sheriff's Office in 1986 and is still there today.

Capt. LeCocq began his career as a dispatcher, then corrections officer, village rotary and litter enforcement officer. He moved to full time patrol duty in 1991 and progressed through the ranks of sergeant, lieutenant, and today the captain of the patrol division. That division encompasses 37 uniformed patrol deputies, 4 sergeants, and 3 lieutenants. This position involves planning, staffing, financing, training, policy development and equipment procurement. Capt. LeCocq has had various special assignments throughout his career, including that of crisis negotiator, role he still performs today. Over the course of his career, Capt. LeCocq has worked with numerous community partners, including Allwell Behavioral Health, NAMI of Ohio and this Board to provide annual Crisis Intervention Training to law enforcement officers in the Board service area. Capt. LeCocq was first appointed to serve on the board in June 2015 and reappointed in 2018. He resides in Wayne Township with his wife Gina.
